What is R.O.M.

A Program established by WHOA in 1989 to provide the plantation pleasure horses and their exhibitors a showcase for their versatility

How to get started? For more information, or to nominate your horse for the Register of Merit Program, contact the WHOA office at 615-494-8822 or email:

office@walkinghorseowners.com. You'll receive a rule book

that explains the program in detail as well as all the class award divisions. Keep track of your points in the book provided. If you show in a class not listed that's Okay. List it in your point book anyway. It will be

assigned (if at all possible) to the most likely division so your points will count.

Register of Merit Program: To be eligible for awards, the owner of the horse must be a WHOA member, the horse must be a registered Tennessee Walking Horse at

least 2 years old, and the horse must be nominated by September 1 of each calendar year. Points count only from the time the owner became a WHOA member. Point books are issued each year and must be submitted by December 5 for yearly awards presented each February at the WHOA National Convention. Points are earned by placing at any organized horse show, competitive or endurance ride, or other event. Horses and riders do not have to compete in every division to win awards.

Awards:

Awards include the Certificate of Achievement, a yearly award based on points earned in individual divisions for that show year only, Certificate of Merit, a cumulative award that is issued when a horse has earned the required number of points in four groupings of divisions, and the Register of Merit, the highest honor a plantation horse can receive. Register of Merit awards are presented each year at the WHOA National Convention.
