full membership privileges and never need renewal.

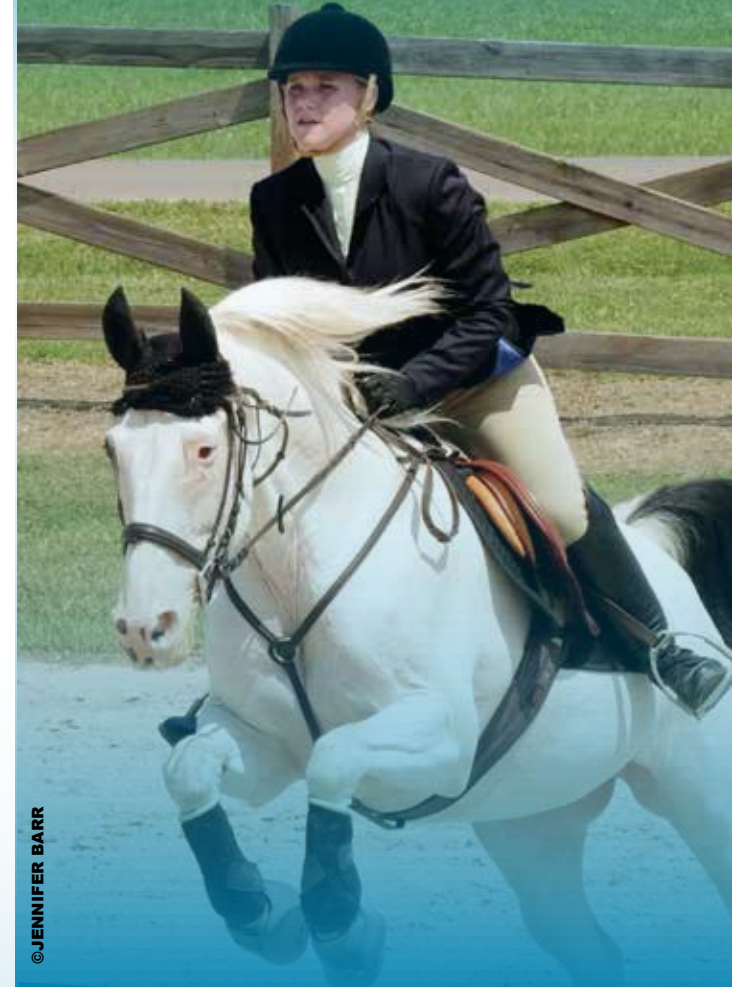
